



INTERNATIONAL BACCALAUREATE REGISTRATION INFORMATION

For Grade 9 Students Applying To HARRY AINLAY HIGH SCHOOL

Grade 9 students require an 80% **combined average** in English, Social, Math and Science in order to apply to our Grade 10 Harry Ainlay Pre-IB Diploma program. The Grade 10 year focuses on skill building in order to ensure an adequate preparation for the curriculum demands of the IB program which is completed in grades 11 and 12. **Grade 10 students, who wish to enroll in IB in Grade 11, must take our Grade 10 Harry Ainlay Pre-IB Diploma program. Students are then required to enroll in a full Pre-IB Diploma schedule which will allow them to pursue the full IB Diploma Program in grades 11 and 12.**

Credit total should be 44 or 45 Credits

* IB Language: French 10 pIB, French Language Arts 10 pIB (Immersion students), German 10 pIB, Japanese 10 pIB, Spanish 10 pIB,

**Students MUST have at least 3 years of experience to register in
French or Spanish**

**Options: Choose one 5 credit option and one 3 credit option
OR three 3 credit options.

We highly recommend taking a Fine Arts course i.e. Art 10 pIB, Drama 10 pIB, Music 10 pIB or students could take a second pIB International language.

Any option course is acceptable though.

- A 10 credit course (e.g. Symphonic Band) will fit only if you take P.E. 10 in Summer School (although this is the only time that we would recommend P.E at Summer School as students are better served having the stress release during the regular Grade 10 year).
- Leadership 15 is taught outside of regular class time and so will result in an even higher credit count for the student than the standard total of 44-45.
